

G.E.N. Education designs this Creative Storytelling Bootcamp for 9th - 11th graders. Storytelling is a critical skill for the 21st century. Whether students are telling their story to share a new idea or perspective, to apply for school, or to get a job, it is essentially that they create a cohesive narrative landscape that captures the attention of their audience. This Creative Storytelling Bootcamp focuses on developing students' speaking skills and oral storytelling skills. Students will explore plot, narrative, and selection of detail as they brainstorm ideas. Students will also work on their public speaking and oral delivery skills as they focus on speaking strategies, body language, and tone.

Our instructor, Ms. Ashley, a graduate of the University of Chicago in English Language and Literature. Ashley has spent her professional career educating students on storytelling, writing, and effective communication. After working in Hong Kong as an admissions consultant with results to top universities and colleges, Ashley moved to the prestigious Schwarzman College to direct the inaugural Writing Center Manager and developed academic and professional writing programs.
